

Autism Bereavement Project Invitation to Submit Logo Design

Hospice Foundation of America (HFA) was awarded a five-year grant by the Nancy Lurie Marks Family Foundation (NLMFF) that will focus on providing online and printed resources to support adults with autism who are grieving. The outcome of the project will be a website (www.autismandgrief.org) for adults with autism; their families; and professionals, such as clergy, doctors, nurses, social workers, employers, and educators. We are inviting autistic adults with artistic skill to submit a logo design for the project. The logo will be used on the new website, social media, printable/shareable resources, promotion materials, and in email communications. Tap into your creativity and create a unique logo concept for a great cause! The chosen artist/designer will be profiled on the website and will receive an honorarium of \$350 and a plaque recognizing their contribution.

Eligibility: Autistic adults aged 18+

Submission Guidelines: One logo design submitted in the form of sketches, illustration, etc. The logo will be used online and in print, so it must be scalable and recognizable when resized. It may be used in black & white as well as color. The final version will need to be suitable for high quality printing. The logo cannot include text, copyrighted or proprietary clip art or stock images, and it should not resemble logos associated with autism organizations or advocacy groups.

Copyright/intellectual property: The chosen logo will be registered as a Trademark. Submissions should not in any way appear similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images. All entry materials become the exclusive property of Nancy Lurie Marks Family Foundation (NLMFF) and will not be returned. Any and all intellectual property rights in and ownership of the chosen submission will be deemed transferred at the time of submission. NLMFF shall have the right to adapt, edit, modify, or otherwise use the winning submission in part or in its entirety in whatever manner it deems appropriate.
